CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES – JANUARY 2011

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for January 2011 on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

Key points:

- Average Daily Trips of 22,255 was 7.08% lower than December 2010.
- Average Workday Trips was 25,792 a decrease of 7.39% compared to December 2010.
- Flooding in Brisbane affected traffic in the week commencing 10 January 2011.
- Due to the flooding in Brisbane, the CLEM7 operated toll-free from 1:30pm 12 January 2011 to midnight 17 January 2011. The average daily traffic during the toll-free period was 25,690.
- Some school extended holidays due to the flooding.
