## **6 MONTHLY TRAFFIC COUNTS – MARCH 2009**

### **4% INCREASE IN TRAFFIC ACROSS BRISBANE RIVER**

Average daily traffic increased by 4% in the past 12 months on five bridges crossing the Brisbane River, according to the latest traffic counts commissioned by RiverCity Motorway Group.

During March 2009, an average of 394,150 vehicles crossed the Gateway Bridge, Story Bridge, Captain Cook Bridge, William Jolly Bridge and Victoria Bridge per day, compared to 378,825 vehicles per day in March 2008.

Other key findings from the survey include:

- average daily traffic increased by 4.6% on the Gateway Bridge and 2.9% on the Captain Cook Bridge during the period, while traffic on the Story Bridge reduced by 0.5%;
- ongoing commercial and residential development in South Brisbane has seen average daily traffic increase by 15% on the William Jolly Bridge and 15.9% Victoria Bridge;
- roadwork at Woolloongabba associated with the CLEM7 and Boggo Road Busway appears to be affecting traffic volumes on Ipswich Road which are down by 8.4%;
- continuing roadwork at Bowen Hills associated with the CLEM7 and Northern Busway are likely to have contributed to a 2.9% reduction in daily traffic on Lutwyche Road;
- average daily traffic increased on Abbotsford Road (+3.1%), Pacific Motorway (+3.0%) and Wynnum Road (+2.0%); and
- growth during the off-peak is continuing as the morning and afternoon peaks reach capacity.

RiverCity Motorway Group Chairman, Bob Morris, said the Group was pleased to see overall traffic increase in the tunnel catchment despite the challenges of coping with construction works for the CLEM7, Airport Link, Northern Busway and Boggo Road Busway, as well as the current difficult economic climate.

Every six months RiverCity Motorway Group commissions traffic counts during a 2-week period on Brisbane's major river crossings and the tunnel's key feeder roads.

The most recent survey was completed between 16 and 29 March 2009.
