TOLL DISCOUNT PERIOD TO COMMENCE 6 APRIL 2010

The Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7) will commence tolling from Tuesday 6 April 2010. This follows a 3-week toll-free period that ends at midnight on Monday, 5 April 2010.

From 6 April until 9 May 2010, the CLEM7 will remain toll-free between the hours of midnight and 5.00am. For the remainder of the day, tolls for all motorists will be discounted by 30%.

The 30% discount means cars will be charged only \$2.95 to use the CLEM7. Motorbikes pay \$1.48, light commercial vehicles pay \$4.43 and heavy commercial vehicles pay \$7.82.

CLEM7 is also waiving image processing fees (normally 40c per trip) for all motorists travelling without a tag, regardless of vehicle type or tolling services provider until 30 September 2010.

RiverCity Motorway CEO Flan Cleary said the period of reduced tolls and fees was a natural extension to the toll-free period.

“The CLEM7 is doing wonders for Brisbane traffic bypassing up to 24 sets of traffic lights and offering motorists faster, safer and more reliable travel.

“Saving time and money is a great reason for Brisbane motorists to test-drive the CLEM7,” Mr Cleary said.

Brisbane’s first major road tunnel, the CLEM7 connects with Lutwyche Road, the Inner City Bypass, Shafston Avenue, the Pacific Motorway and Ipswich Road.
