CLEM7 TUNNEL CAR TOLL REDUCED TO \$2.00

The toll for cars to use Brisbane's CLEM7 tunnel will be reduced to \$2.00 from 1 July 2010.

"To travel 6.8 kilometres under the Brisbane CBD saving up to 20 minutes for \$2.00 is great value," said RiverCity Motorway CEO, Flan Cleary.

"Our decision to reduce tolls is in response to feedback from Brisbane motorists that they are more likely to use the tunnel if the toll is set at \$2.00," Mr Cleary said.

"We have listened to Brisbane motorists. Now we ask Brisbane motorists to support this great piece of infrastructure for the city.

"Our research shows that motorists who currently use the CLEM7 love it and value the way it saves time. Motorists can use the CLEM7 to reduce their travel times by 50%.

"Our challenge is to get more Brisbane motorists to experience the tunnel for themselves and we believe the \$2.00 toll will do just that," he said.

Mr Cleary said the reduced toll levels across all vehicle types would remain in place for the next 3 months.

Heavy Commercial Vehicle	\$5.30
Motorbike	\$1.00

The 6.8 kilometre CLEM7 connects with Lutwyche Road, Inner City Bypass, Shafston Avenue, the Pacific Motorway and Ipswich Road.
